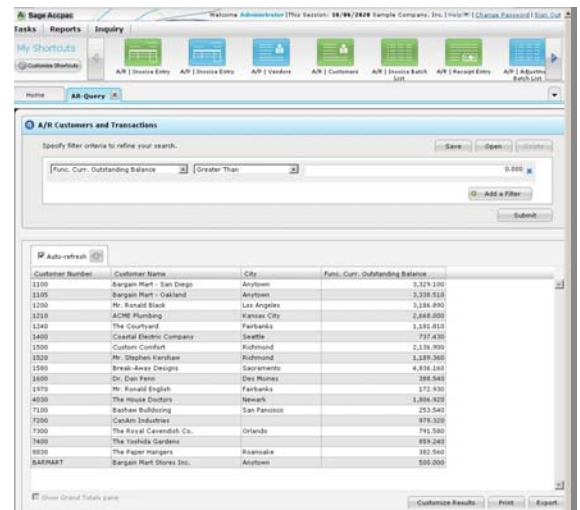
Getting Data Out Can Be Difficult
